The Society

The Morwell Numismatic Society was founded in 1965 by a group of coin collectors and has been functioning ever since.

Objectives

It is the purpose of the Society to encourage and further the interest in the study, research and knowledge of Coins, Banknotes and all other matters pertaining to money, and to promote an interchange of collecting and study interest between members. Activities
