

## NAV Tender Sale – February 2018

The Numismatic Association of Victoria (NAV) are holding their next Tender Sale during their February Meeting at 400-420 William Street, West Melbourne on Friday 16th February. The sale will commence after our Annual General Meeting has concluded.

In this sale we not only have a diverse range of items from militaria to mint sets and from Australian coins to banknotes, but we're also offering the first lot of numismatic literature from the NAV Library. This initial batch focuses on British and British Commonwealth coinage.

With the library seldom used by members it was decided a number of years ago to sell most (but not all) of the items in it to raise money for the Association. Some of these books are seldom made available these days and if they are then they're frequently overseas meaning ever increasing postage costs can make them expensive to obtain. This is a great opportunity for members, and others that may be interested, to add to their own numismatic libraries<sup>1</sup>.

Postal bids are welcome and will be placed at 10% above floor bids, up to the maximum amount specified.
