REPORT TO NUMISMATIC ASSOCIATION OF VICTORIA ON PRESS AND OTHER PUBLICITY.

Mr. Chairman. Ladies & Gentlemen.

21st March. 1947.

I will briefly outline the publicity afforded our Association during the last three months. It will be recalled our December meeting was more of a social nature, and although an abbreviated account of the evening was left with three newspapers, their views of our activities were not to their interest, consequently no write up appeared in the news.

Of the last meeting, my absence was the cause of not obtaining sufficient data to prepare some form of publicity, however, it is hoped this will be rectified later. Several publications, both daily and weekly, have been approached, and the results can be summarized as follows:-

The Age

15th February.

A brief note of the intended issue of the new Sth.

African five shilling piece appeared in this issue.

(Unfortunately the title of Victorian Numismatic

Society, appeared in the text - a printers error, or perhaps a reporter's mistake.)

The Sun News Pictorial Supplied with information several weeks ago, but not published.

The Argus

This paper was approached with the idea of running a weekly illustration of famous coins, to be inserted in Saturday's Magazine, but the suggestion did not appeal. However, an article on numismatics, with the human interest side, bringing in collectors, would be acceptable. Members could supply information to somebody of a journalistic leaning.

The Australasian Post This weekly is prepared to accept anything of news value, and acceded to a request to publish the information regarding the five shilling Sth. African coin, this appeared in the issue of the 6th March. January 23rd.

The Herald

On this date, a brief account, together with an illustration, was made of the Bledisloe-Waitangi medal of the New Zealand Numismatic Society. The medal was kindly loaned by our secretary, following its exhibition at the meeting. The mention of our Association was regrettably deleted.

The Digest of World Reading.

PUBLICITY OFFICER.

Cupro-Nickels are alloys of Nickel and Copper. Nickel is the preponderating element, thus a 30% Cupro Nickel has 30% Copper, 70% Nickel.

Nickel Silvers are alloys of Copper, Zinc and Nickel. Here Nickel is the Minor element. Nickel Silvers are based on 60% Copper, 40% Zinc brass in which some zinc is replaced by Nickel, thus as an approximation, 10%, 15% and 20% Nickel Silvers are as in table.

Zinc	30%	25%	20%

The only feature about the English Cupro Nickel is that it can be melted in the Royal Mint Furnaces. Pure Nickel cannot be melted in the existing furnaces. Nickel (pure) is superior as a coinage alloy. The alloy chosen for the new coinage is white and silvery, and not at all unpleasing in its appearance.

Incidently there was some correspondence and criticism in the English press concerning the use of Cupro Nickel instead of pure Nickel in this work.
